### **Bed tax collection**

The preliminary resort tax collected for December 2021 was \$5,320,349, a 43.5% increase over December 2020 preliminary collections of \$3,707,002. Fiscal year-to-date preliminary tourist tax collections are \$12,863,257, an increase of 53.1% year-over-year.

### Airport news

During December 2021, 1,085,569 passengers traveled through Southwest Florida International Airport, an increase of 67.5% compared to December 2020. Year-to-date, passenger traffic is up 72.7% from the same period last year.

### **Sports Development report**

Jeff Mielke, sports development director, reported that 64,851 room nights sold in the months of October through December 2021 with direct visitor spending of more than \$30.2 million. For calendar year 2021, 181,079 room nights were sold and there was a total of \$72,545,752 in direct visitor spending.

### Hotel industry overview

Hannah Smith, STR senior consultant, gave an update on the lodging market including national statistics, Lee County's performance, a county comparison and a forecast for 2023.

### New business

Tamara Pigott, VCB executive director, presented first quarter budget reports for the VCB and Sports Development, which were approved unanimously.
