It's time! Island Hopper Songwriter Fest kicks off Friday on Captiva Island

10 days of music includes downtown Fort Myers and Fort Myers Beach, Sept. 16-25

LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA – The eighth Island Hopper Songwriter Fest kicks off this weekend in the tropical setting of Captiva Island, Sept. 16-18, then moves to historic downtown Fort Myers, Sept. 19-22, and wraps up on Fort Myers Beach, Sept. 23-25.

Most shows are free, with the exception of a few ticketed experiences, such as headliner shows. Fans can select their favorites from 82 singer-songwriters who will perform more than 100 shows.

Headliner: <u>Gary LeVox</u>, frontman for Rascal Flatts, performs at 5 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 25, poolside at the Pink Shell Beach Resort & Marina. Tickets for the LeVox concert are available on the Island Hopper app or at <u>island-hopperfest.visitfortmyers.com/artist/gary-levox</u>.

In addition to LeVox, some of the BMI singer-songwriters performing this year include:

- Kristian Bush, two-time Grammy award winner and half of the Sugarland duo, solo hit with "Trailer Hitch"
- <u>Alana Springsteen</u>, named a 2021 County Artist to Watch by Pandora; EP "History of Breaking UP (Part One and Two)"
- <u>Aaron Barker</u>, who has written songs for George Strait ("Easy Come, Easy Go"), Clay Walker and Willie Nelson

- <u>Autumn Nicholas</u>, reminiscent of singer/songwriter Julia Michaels with the swagger of Kasey Musgraves and the soul of Etta James (EP "Shades of Beige")
- <u>Dave Pahanish</u>, who co-wrote the No. 1 Billboard Country music singles "Do You Believe Me Now" by Jimmy Wayne, "American Ride" by Toby Keith and "Without You" by Keith Urban
- <u>Chasing Denver</u>, a husband-wife duo from south Florida with the fan favorite, "Spinnin'

Big winner: Island Hopper recently won three first-place SUNsational Awards at the recent Florida Festivals & Events Association convention in Orlando for mobile app, virtual event (Songs from the Sand) and installations (bus wrap).
