#### Murals depict history of downtown Fort Myers

The River Basin Mural Project is currently underway as 53 murals by 36 artists are being installed in downtown Fort Myers. Coordinated by the Fort Myers Mural Society, the new project tells the story of the area and its relationship with the Fort Myers riverfront.
