## **Island Hopper Songwriter Fest shatters attendance record**

10-day event sees 23 percent increase over last year

**LEE COUNTY, FL** – People love live music and this year's Island Hopper audiences prove it.

Attendance at the fifth annual Island Hopper Songwriter Fest increased by 23 percent over last year. The 10-day event was held Sept. 21-30 on Captiva, historic downtown Fort Myers and Fort Myers Beach.

Island Hopper showcased 79 singer-songwriters in 155 performances, entertaining more than 18,000 guests with the stories behind the songs.

"Island Hopper continues to energize our community when we need it the most," said Lee County Commission Chairman and Tourist Development Council Chairman Cecil Pendergrass.
