Preliminary November tax breaks another record

The preliminary resort tax collected for November 2015 was \$2,040,654, a 9.1 percent increase over November 2014 preliminary collections of \$1,869,592. Fiscal year-over-year collections increased 12.4 percent, with a total of \$4,038,523 collected.

Airport news

During November 2015, 720,556 passengers traveled through Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW), an increase of 7.6 percent compared to November 2014. Year-to-date, passenger traffic was 7,536,442, a 4.6 percent from the same period last year.

Events Marketing vs. Marketing Funding

The TDC approved a criteria change recommendation that allows attraction and/or event marketing funding applicants to submit two TDC funding requests per year (two event funding applications or one attraction and one event marketing funding applications).
